In order that the required documents are prepared for signature at the time of the marriage, please **complete fully** all items on the attached form and return the form immediately to the officiating marriage commissioner at the address shown above.

**\*Important Notes\***

1. It is required by law that all marriages shall be contracted in the presence of two or more responsible witnesses who are eighteen years of age or over. These witnesses are in addition to the marriage commissioner performing the marriage ceremony and are provided by the parties wishing to be married.
2. Prior to the marriage ceremony, the following documents must be presented to the marriage commissioner:  
A Saskatchewan Marriage License which has been issued within three months prior to the marriage, together with the following attachments if applicable.
  - (a) If either party to the marriage is under 18 years of age, a "Consent to Marriage of a Minor" form must be completed and signed by the parent(s) or legal guardian of the minor;
  - (b) If either party to the marriage is under 16 years of age, a statement from a judge of the Saskatchewan Provincial Court permitting the marriage. This statement is in addition to the "Consent to Marriage of a Minor" form mentioned in 2(a).
3. No marriage commissioner shall solemnize a marriage if there is reason to believe that the judgment of either party to the marriage is impaired by the use of alcohol or drugs.
